



ALUMNI 25TH YEAR REUNION (SEPTEMBER 4, 5, 6 - 2009)

REUNION Q&A

- **Is the reunion for campers AND staff?** Yes. Anyone who attended MTC as a camper or counselor is welcome, with family/guests! There are restrictions upon those under the age of 18. Please see the registration form for details.
- **When should I register?** Right now if possible! Space is limited to first-come, first-serve.
- **What is the latest I can register?** Registrations are accepted until August 21, 2009, unless we fill early!
- **How much is registration and what does it cover?** Basic registration fees are 25.00 per person (children 5 and under are FREE). This covers your attendance for the entire weekend and you can do as many of the designated activities as you wish. There are additional costs for meals, housing, and transport. See registration form for details.
- **Can I get a refund if I change my mind or something comes up & I can't make it to the reunion?** Yes, but only up until 14 days prior to the reunion date (August 21, 2009).
- **Will there be a list of events available prior to the reunion?** Yes. We will either email or post a structured list of events on the MTC website later in the summer. Some of the events will be: 'Last Chance Dance' and Banquet, the Bob Briskin Tennis Open, basketball game, music "jams", a BBQ & campfire, a slideshow, and a nostalgic display of camp photos and memorabilia. The list will be much more detailed closer to the reunion. **Sorry, there will be NO adventure ropes climbing or water-skiing available.**
- **Are there activities for my small children?** Yes. There will be arts & crafts activities, as well as some general sporting activities & swimming.
- **Where should I fly into?** The closest airport is Portland International Jetport (45min). We provide optional shuttle service for a nominal fee. If you are renting a car, you may wish to fly into Manchester, NH or Boston, MA. We will also provide shuttle service (\$) from Greyhound Bus, Concord Trailways(bus), or the Amtrak train station. If you sign up for shuttles, please be aware that there will be some wait time involved.
- **Is there ample parking for my vehicle?** Yes. We will have designated parking areas for your personal vehicles.
- **Do you have lodging recommendations outside of camp?** Check out these links: www.mainemidwaylodging.com, www.cornishinn.com, www.hiexpress.com, www.northconwaynh.com. If you do not stay at camp, keep in mind that the reunion falls on Labor Day Weekend, a big holiday in the USA. Book off-site accommodations as early as possible and DON'T PROCRASTINATE!
- **Does MTC provide tents?** No, but you are welcome to bring your own (see registration form).
- **If I bring a tent, can I use the shower/toilet facilities?** Absolutely yes.
- **Do I need to bring my own linens/sleeping bags?** Yes. There are no linens/blankets provided by MTC.
- **Will there be supervision for my small children?** No. You are responsible for your children at all times. Designated swim times will be supervised by lifeguards, but parents/guardians are still required to be at the waterfront.
- **Can I come & go from the reunion?** Yes. However, if you are a parent/legal guardian with children under age 18 at the event, you must take them with you whenever you leave camp property.
- **Do you cater to special diets?** As an alternative to the regular menu, we will have vegetarian options available only.
- **Can I bring my pet(s)?** No pets please. Please note that you may contact us about the family dog. Please do not assume that your dog will be allowed on camp grounds.
- **Will I be able to buy an alumni t-shirt or souvenir?** Yes, there will be reunion items available for purchase.
- **Can I volunteer at the reunion?** Absolutely! Please see a camp administrator when you arrive at MTC, or email us ahead of time.
- **Is smoking allowed at the reunion?** Yes, but only in one designated smoking area.
- **Can I bring my own alcohol to MTC?** Absolutely not. MTC will provide alcoholic beverages only at specific times during the weekend. NO other alcohol is allowed to be consumed at any other times on camp grounds. Keep in mind that drunken or unruly behavior will not be tolerated.
- **Can I arrive early to the reunion?** Please, NO early arrivals. We ask that you adhere to time guidelines on the registration form.
- **If I'm a musician, will there be an opportunity to play at the dance?** Absolutely! We look forward to "hearing" from you on Saturday night!
- **What are the proceeds of the reunion going toward at camp?** After expenses, any proceeds made are going toward the future construction of our new music studio – MTC is well known for being one of the best summer camps for rock music instruction and we want to make it even better in the very near future!

****Refund Policy:** In case of cancellation before **August 21st, 2009, all funds will be refunded (14 days prior to reunion weekend).** After August 21st, 2009, all funds are forfeited. Payment is due in full upon registration. There are no refunds for non-arrival, late arrival, or early departure for any reason. No refunds are issued for discontinuation of the reunion due to acts of God, natural disaster, acts of war, terrorism, or epidemics.

Maine Teen Camp General Policies (please indicate that you have read and accept our policies by signing below):

1. All attendees to the reunion must sign a personal liability waiver (page 4 of this form).
2. Maine Teen Camp will not be responsible for lost or stolen cash, personal belongings, or damage to personal belongings while at camp.
3. Maine Teen Camp will not be held responsible for personal injury or illness.
4. Each attendee is responsible for his/her own personal safety and medical care. There is a local health clinic in the nearby town for anyone needing medical attention. We are 25 min. from Bridgton Hospital. We use 911 for emergencies.
5. A reunion attendee under the age of 18 MUST bring a parent/legal guardian with them to the reunion and that individual must remain for the length of the reunion. A reunion attendee under the age of 18 who arrives without a parent/legal guardian will not be permitted to remain at the Alumni Reunion or on camp grounds.
6. Parents/legal guardians are responsible at all times for their children who may be attending the reunion and are expected to explain and reinforce our policies to all family members.
7. Please adhere to designated arrival times. Please arrange to arrive no earlier than 4pm on Friday. Departure time on Sunday is 11am.
8. Smoking (for those over the age of 18) will be permitted, but in one specific area ONLY.
9. For those over the age of 21, there will be alcohol served for night functions only. Attendees may not bring outside alcohol to reunion events. Attendees must be prepared to show proper ID. It is illegal to furnish alcohol to minors. The use of illegal drugs or abuse of substances will not be tolerated and are punishable to the fullest extent of Maine state law.
10. No pets please. Dogs permitted ONLY with permission by owners/directors. Please contact us to discuss.
11. Parking areas are indicated at camp. Please DO NOT park on the grassed areas.
12. Please respect the natural environment and gardens of camp.
13. Attendees must leave the cabins and facility free of personal effects and trash.
14. Attendees will be expected to provide your own sleeping bag, linens, towels, etc.
15. The Maine Teen Camp waterfront areas are only open to attendees when we designate open times for use with trained lifeguards present. Our high/low ropes course and climbing wall will NOT be open for use. These rules are for each attendee's safety!
16. Weapons of any kind are not permitted on camp grounds. Leave knives and firearms at home!
17. Fireworks are not permitted in the state of Maine.
18. Respect the local community – please understand that there is a 12 midnight noise-reduction curfew.
19. Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and anyone causing difficulties will be asked to leave the premises. There are no refunds issued for dismissal.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT
MPR Summers Inc. dba Maine Teen Camp

Waiver: In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in the **Maine Teen Camp Alumni Reunion, September 4-6, 2009**, (hereinafter **'the Activity'**), I, for myself, and my immediate family participating in the activity, my heirs, personal representatives or assignees, do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue or hold in any way responsible, MPR Summers Inc., dba Maine Teen Camp, its owners, directors, officers, employees, and agents from liability from any and all claims arising during the course of the Activity. The waiver of liability includes but is not limited to potential claims of negligence against MPR Summers Inc., dba Maine Teen Camp, its owners, directors, officers, employees and agents, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and/or property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in the Activity. The term 'Activity' as used to describe the events of the Maine Teen Camp Alumni Reunion is to be construed as broadly as permitted under the laws of the State of Maine and is defined to include all events, activities, free time, residential time, and all time spent on or around the property of the Maine Teen Camp during the course of the 2009 Alumni Reunion whether or not this time is part of an organized reunion event.

Assumption of Risks: Participation in the Activity carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of care taken to avoid injuries. I have read the previous paragraphs and I know, understand, and appreciate these and other risks that are inherent in the Activity. I hereby assert that my participation is voluntary and that I knowingly assume all such risks.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: I also agree to Indemnify and Hold MPR Summers Inc., dba Maine Teen Camp Harmless from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my involvement in the Activity and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred.

Severability: The undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver and assumption of risks agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Maine and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Acknowledgement of Understanding: I have read this waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, fully understand its terms, and understand that I am giving up substantial rights, including my right to sue. I acknowledge that I am signing the agreement freely and voluntarily, and intend by my signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law. I understand that failure to sign this document will disqualify me from participation in the Activity and I will not be permitted on or around camp grounds during the entirety of the Activity.
