Camper Arrival Flight Information 2024

“International Arrival Day” is the day **BEFORE** official start dates.

Session 1 INTL arrival day: **June 22nd**

Session 2 INTL arrival day: **July 20th**

Please complete **the online travel** form found on the online portal so we know how your camper/s will arrive to and depart camp.

- Boston Logan (**BOS**) and Portland Jetport (**PWM**) are our arrival/departure airports
- **International campers:** please book flights to **arrive between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM** (if possible)
- **Domestic campers:** Please book flights to **land no later than 2:00 PM**
- It is approximately a 2-hour drive one way from Boston and 1 hour from Portland
- Transfer costs are: **\$400 round trip** (BOS) & **\$50 round trip** (PWM)
- Final travel confirmations will be sent out a few days before travel days. This includes what to look out for at the airport and final information. Our staff will be at the airport to pick up your camper as soon as they disembark and collect baggage.

International Campers: Most of our international campers fly into the regional hub airport, Boston Logan Airport (airport code BOS). International campers can fly into BOS or PWM, but flights into PWM will likely involve a connection. We do advise avoiding connecting flights if possible. When booking arrivals, and departures, please be mindful of the 2–3 hour travel from camp. For a camper arriving into Boston on a 9pm flight, they may not arrive at camp until after midnight. Similarly, a camper departing from Boston on a 6am flight would have to leave camp at around 2am.

American Campers: If your camper resides in the USA, please book flights to Portland Jetport (PWM) when possible. (The transfer fees for the airport are \$50 round trip for PWM, and \$400 round trip for BOS). Please contact us if your camper is unable to fly into PWM. *West coast families (CA and ORE), we request that your camper arrives prior to 1:00 PM on arrival day. If this is not possible campers may arrive on international arrival day (the day before). Please confirm with our office BEFORE booking. This applies to campers flying to camp and requiring a pickup, **not** parent drop offs.*

If your camper is arriving on any other date, please contact us.

Departure day: We ask that you book flights leaving between **11:00 AM – 5:00 PM**. These are recommendations only but please book flights **within** our respected arrival/departure times. Please do send us a quick email to confirm that the times you have selected are okay BEFORE you book.

Unaccompanied Minors: Any young campers who will be flying as an unaccompanied minor, for which you are paying the airline an additional fee, must notify us once a booking has been confirmed. Flight times still must be within the time frame shown above. Please complete and forward as much UM paperwork prior to your camper travelling to camp, including a receipt for the UM service.

BE prepared that your airline may not allow you to complete all the UM paperwork, including Designated Pick Up, until check-in. If this is the case, we will provide you with the EXACT name of the pick up person (who will be on site at the airport the day of your campers arrival) 24–48 hours prior to arrival.

IF the airline requires the name of the Designated Pick Up person when BOOKING the flight, you can use the information below at the time of booking. Upon check-in, request a change to the designated pick up person to match the information we will email to you 24–48 hours prior to arrival.

Things to know:

- All campers on arriving flights will be met by staff as soon as they come through security and have their baggage. Emails will be sent around a week before arrival with instructions on for your camper.
- Please let us know as soon as possible if you are booking your camper as an unaccompanied minor.
- We have staff in each of our terminals meeting your campers. There may be around a 1 hour wait to load your campers onto one of our air-conditioned shuttles to camp, as we have multiple campers arriving.
- Please pack your campers snacks accordingly. There may be a while from the time they leave their home to arrival at camp. Food and snacks will be available throughout the day and if a camper arrives after dinner, there will be meals available.
- There is no need to send boarding passes prior, these will be ticketed at the airport.
